**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO CALL FOR BIDS FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF THE GRANT LINE ROAD/STATE ROUTE 99 INTERCHANGE
RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT**

WHEREAS, improving the existing Grant Line Road/State Route 99 interchange holds a high priority in the City of Elk Grove Transportation Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the current interchange, constructed in 1956, does not meet current design and safety standards, and lacks adequate capacity to serve present and expected future traffic volumes using the interchange.






