**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
SUPPORTING PROPOSITIONS 1A, 1B, 1C, AND 1E
ON THE NOVEMBER 2006 BALLOT**

WHEREAS, California voters will be asked to consider a package of infrastructure bonds on the November 2006 ballot, and

WHEREAS, Proposition 1A would enhance protections for existing transportation funds, and

WHEREAS, Proposition 1B would provide \$19.9 billion in general obligation bonds for transportation improvements, and


WHEREAS, Proposition 1C would provide \$2.85 billion for a variety of housing and emergency shelter projects, and

WHEREAS, Proposition 1E would provide \$4 billion for evaluating, repairing, and replacing levees and flood control infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, Propositions 1A, 1B, 1C, and 1E will help improve and strengthen critical infrastructure in the City of Elk Grove and the state of California.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby supports Propositions 1A, 1B, 1C, and 1E on the November 2006 Ballot.




