A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE ADOPTING THE SUBSTANTIVE AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2008-09 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ACTION PLAN AND TO THE AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2009-10 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ACTION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), authorized pursuant to Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, requires that jurisdictions provide for the issuance of grants in order to obtain the objective of providing decent housing, expending economic opportunities, or providing a suitable living environment, principally for low- and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is the federal agency that promulgates regulations and oversees the administration of the CDBG program that the funds are granted under; and

WHEREAS, HUD requires that entitlement jurisdictions complete a plan for expending the funds on eligible activities, referred to as the Action Plan, and amend it as necessary to accommodate significant changes in the usage of funds; and

WHEREAS, staff has completed the Substantive Amendment to the 2008-09 Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, staff has completed the amendment to the 2009-10 Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the amendment to the Action Plan and a public notice announcing the 30-day public comment period for the report have been published for citizen comment prior to forwarding the document to City Council for adoption; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on October 19, 2009, to provide an opportunity for the public to comment on the information in the amendment to the Action Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove:

- 1) Adopts the Substantive Amendment to the 2008-09 Action Plan;
- 2) Adopts the amendment to the 2009-10 CDBG Action Plan;
- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to submit the amendment and all required certifications and forms to the Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

4) Allows staff to make technical modifications to the Action Plan to correct minor errors or as required by HUD.
