## **RESOLUTION NO. 2010-145**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2011-15 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND FISCAL YEAR 2010-11 BUDGET BY APPROVING THE ALLOCATION OF \$2,468,000 IN EAST FRANKLIN LANDSCAPE CORRIDOR FEE FUNDING FOR THE SAFETY, STREETSCAPING, AND BICYCLE / PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the landscaping fee component was originally established in the Laguna South Public Facilities Fee Program (LSPFFP) in 2001 to fund the cost of landscape corridor improvements in the East Franklin Specific Plan; and

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2005, the City Council approved the East Franklin Landscape Corridor and Supplemental Drainage Fee Program Nexus Study (Nexus Study) and Chapter 16.81 of the Elk Grove Municipal Code which reflected the East Franklin Fee Program as being separate from the LSPFFP; and

WHEREAS, the East Franklin Landscape Corridor Fee was established to fund costs for landscape corridor facilities including the costs for landscaping of roadway, railroad, interceptor, and drainage corridors; and

WHEREAS, staff has identified the following eligible landscaping and trail projects that will provide benefit to the East Franklin Area and are consistent with the Nexus Study:

- 1) Whitelock Parkway Landscaping
- 2) Shed A Multi-Use Trail
- 3) Various Landscaping Improvements
- 4) Gilliam Drive Trail Connector

WHEREAS, staff recommends amending the Fiscal Year 2010-11 budget and Fiscal Year 2011-15 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) to include these projects as part of the Safety, Streetscaping, and Bicycle / Pedestrian Improvements Program since the projects involve landscaping as well as bicycle and pedestrian-related improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission reviewed this onging capital program and found it to be consistent with the City's General Plan on May 26, 2010.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby amends the Fiscal Year 2011-15 Capital Improvement Program and the Fiscal Year 2010-11 budget by approving the allocation of \$2,468,000 in East Franklin Landscape Corridor Fee funding for the Safety, Streetscaping, and Bicycle / Pedestrian Improvements Program.
