A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE FINDING
THE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE SHELDON ROAD INTERCHANGE PARK AND RIDE
LOT EXEMPT FROM CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT REVIEW
PURSUANT TO SECTION 15183 OF THE CEQA GUIDELINES OF TITLE 14 OF THE
CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove wishes to install improvements on the existing Park and Ride Lot adjacent to the Sheldon Road / State Route 99 Interchange consisting of an entrance traffic signal, two bus shelters, twenty bicycle lockers, and landscaping; and

WHEREAS, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines §15301 exempts from CEQA review minor alteration of public facilities where the alterations do not result in the expansion of the existing use; and

WHEREAS, all the proposed improvements are accessory to the existing Park and Ride lot and they do not increase or modify the capacity of the lot; and

WHEREAS, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines §15304 exempts from CEQA review minor landscaping of public facilities; and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements were considered in the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the Sheldon Road Interchange Project, which was certified by the City Council on July 27, 2005; and

WHEREAS, no adverse environmental effects were identified during staff review of the proposed improvements; and

WHEREAS, no special circumstances exist that create a reasonable possibility that the activity may have a significant adverse impact on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove finds the improvements to the Sheldon Road Interchange Park and Ride lot exempt from CEQA review pursuant to §15301 and §15304 of the CEQA Guidelines of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.
