A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSULTANT CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH MARK THOMAS AND COMPANY, INC. FOR THE GRANT LINE ROAD WIDENING PROJECT (EAST STOCKTON BOULEVARD TO WATERMAN ROAD) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$148,438 [FOR A TOTAL COMPENSATION AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$1,104,792]

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove and Mark Thomas and Company, Inc. (Mark Thomas) entered into a consultant services contract for the Grant Line Road Widening Project (East Stockton Boulevard to Waterman Road) on December 11, 2008 (Contract No. C-08-396); and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove City Council on January 12, 2011, authorized the City Manager to execute Amendment #1 to the Contract in the amount of \$366,474; and

WHEREAS, there are additional changes to the Project involving relocation of Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD) transmission towers and electrical line undergrounding, design changes resulting from real estate negotiations, and coordination with other utility providers involving relocation of their facilities; and

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2005, the Elk Grove City Council adopted a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Grant Line Widening Project and on October 26, 2011 adopted three addenda and the design for phase 1 of the Grant Line Widening Project; and

WHEREAS, additional professional services are required of Mark Thomas to complete the new design, and bid documents and Mark Thomas has agreed to provide these services for an amount not-to-exceed \$148,438; and

WHEREAS, the Amendment would increase the total compensation allowed under the Consultant Contract from \$956,354 to \$1,104,792 and can be accommodated within the current approved project budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a consultant contract amendment with Mark Thomas and Company, Inc. for the Grant Line Road Widening Project (East Stockton Boulevard to Waterman Road) in the amount of \$148,438 for a total compensation amount not-to-exceed \$1,104,792.
