**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
REJECTING ALL BIDS RECEIVED FOR THE JOHNSTON ROAD PROPERTY
DEMOLITION PROJECT, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RE-BID
THE PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove established the Johnston Road Property Demolition Project (Project) to remove vandalized residential structures to prepare for Civic Center Park future improvements; and

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2014, the City advertised for bids for construction of the Project that included a bid alternate related to Fire Training; and

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2014, many contractors submitting bids were deemed non-responsive because some bid alternate information was confusing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Rejects all bids received; and
- 2) Authorizes the City Manager to re-bid the Project.




