

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-252

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
DISPENSING WITH FURTHER COMPETITIVE PROPOSALS AND AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A SECOND CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH
INTERWEST CONSULTING GROUP FOR BUILDING SAFETY AND INSPECTION
SERVICES TO INCREASE THE TERM OF CONTRACT FOR A PERIOD OF TWO
YEARS, WITH TWO ADDITIONAL TWO-YEAR EXTENSIONS, FOR A TOTAL
AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED 53 PERCENT OF BUILDING PERMIT
AND PLAN CHECK FEE REVENUES**

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) in 2009 for Building Safety and Inspection services; and

WHEREAS, Interwest Consulting Group was determined the most responsive provider of City building services; and


WHEREAS, the current contract term is the first amendment to the original contract and will expire on December 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, this is the second amendment adding an additional two years to the original contract and will expire on December 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, given the quality service and level of support from Interwest Consulting Group, staff proposes a two-year extension to the term of the contract with inclusion of a clause for three additional two-year extensions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove dispenses with further competitive proposals for these continued services as seeking such further proposals is not in the best interest of the City, finds that an extension of the contract with Interwest Consulting Group is in the best interest of the City, and hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a second contract amendment with Interwest Consulting Group for Building Safety and Inspection Services to extend the term of contract for a period of two years, with two additional two-year extensions, for a total amount not-to-exceed 53 percent of Building Permit and Plan Check Fee Revenues (less the portion allocable to the Strong Motion Instrumentation Program, or SMIP).




