

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-269

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AMENDING THE CITY OF ELK GROVE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE**

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2000 the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2000-14, adopting a Conflict of Interest Code incorporating Title 2 of the California Code of Regulations Section 18730, containing the terms of a standard model conflict of interest code and any amendments made thereto; and


WHEREAS, the Conflict of Interest Code was amended by Council Resolution No. 2002-200, Resolution No. 2004-302, Resolution No. 2006-314, Resolution No. 2008-255, Resolution No. 2010-251, and Resolution No. 2012-217 by adding positions required to report; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the review mandated by Government Code Section 87306.5 it has been determined that the list of designated positions appended thereto should be revised.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby finds as follows:

- 1) All provisions of the Conflict of Interest Code adopted by the City Council by Resolution No. 2000-14 shall remain in effect; and
- 2) The list of designated positions is amended as shown in the Exhibit A.
