**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND TO EXECUTE THE
NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR A COOPERATIVE WORK AGREEMENT
EXTENSION BETWEEN THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AND STATE OF CALIFORNIA,
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, WHICH WILL EXTEND THE PERIOD OF
TIME TO EXPEND THE FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS FOR THE KAMMERER ROAD
EXTENSION AND WIDENING PROJECT,
CITY PROJECT WTR015 / FEDERAL PROJECT STPL-5479(037)**

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove has undertaken the Kammerer Road Extension and Widening Project Preliminary Engineering and Environmental document, CIP WTR015 ("Project") to construct a 5.5-mile road connection between Interstate 5 and State Route 99; and

WHEREAS, the City applied for and received a federal grant from the State of California, Department of Transportation ("Caltrans") in 2012 for funding toward preliminary engineering and environmental approval of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the federal funding will lapse on June 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code) (CEQA) requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

WHEREAS, the use of federal funding also qualifies the Project for review under the National Environmental Policy Act (42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.) (NEPA); and

WHEREAS, the proposed Project is a project under both CEQA and NEPA and is currently under environmental review; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove can apply for a Cooperative Work Agreement Extension to extend the federal funding authorization for the project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove or its authorized representative must apply for and sign documents for the Cooperative Work Agreement Extension.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to apply for and execute the necessary documents for a Cooperative Work Agreement Extension between the City of Elk Grove and Caltrans.
