

**RESOLUTION NO. 2016-125**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AND FILE APPLICATIONS  
WITH THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION, AN OPERATING  
ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION, FOR FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE  
AUTHORIZED BY UNITED STATES CODE (U.S.C.) 49, CHAPTER 53, TITLE 23, OR  
OTHER FEDERAL STATUTES ADMINISTERED BY THE FEDERAL TRANSIT  
ADMINISTRATION (SUPERSEDING RESOLUTION NO. 2016-064)**

**WHEREAS**, the Congress of the United States has previously enacted the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century (MAP-21), which was recently superseded by the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act, to fund various transportation programs administered by the Federal Transit Administration; and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Transit Administration has been delegated authority to award Federal financial assistance for a transportation project; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant or cooperative agreement for Federal financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the City of Elk Grove (City), and may require the City to provide the local share of the project cost; and


**WHEREAS**, the City has or will provide all annual certifications and assurances to the Federal Transit Administration required for the project.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Elk Grove:

- 1) That the City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute and file an application for Federal assistance on behalf of the City of Elk Grove with the Federal Transit Administration for Federal assistance authorized by 49 United States Code U.S.C. Chapter 53, Title 23, or other Federal statutes authorizing a project administered by the Federal Transit Administration. The City of Elk Grove has received authority from Sacramento Regional Transit District, the Designated Recipient for the Sacramento Urbanized Area, to apply for Urbanized Formula and Non-Formula Program assistance pursuant for FTA Sections 5307 and 5339.
- 2) That the City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute and file with its applications the annual certifications and assurances and other documents that the Federal Transit Administration requires before awarding Federal assistance grants or cooperative agreements.

- 3) That the City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute grant and cooperative agreements, and file any associated documents, directly with the Federal Transit Administration on behalf of the City of Elk Grove.
- 4) This resolution replaces and supersedes Resolution No. 2016-064 in its entirety.




