

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-171

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
ESTABLISHING REVISED ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS LIMITS FOR FISCAL
YEARS 2002-03 THROUGH 2018-19**

WHEREAS, Article XIII B of the California State Constitution and Government Code Section 7910 requires a City to establish its appropriation limit for each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Article XIII B of the California State Constitution and Government Spending Limitation Section 4 allows a City to change its appropriation limit by the electors of that City subject to and in conformity with constitutional and statutory voting requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby adopts revised Annual Appropriations Limits for Fiscal Year 2002-03 through Fiscal Year 2018-19 as presented in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. This resolution shall take effect immediately.



On June 5, 1990, the California electorate passed Proposition 111, which modified the method of adjusting the annual appropriations limit. Beginning with the 1990-1 appropriations limit, Cities may choose from the following indices when determining the adjustment factor:

Population Factor: The annual growth in the City's population OR the annual growth in the County's population as provided by the State Department of Finance.
AND

Income Factor: The annual growth in the California Per Capita Income OR the growth in the non-residential assessed valuation due to new construction within the City.


