

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-076

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL BIDDING REQUIREMENTS PER ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH ELK GROVE AUTO GROUP, INC., A CALIFORNIA CORPORATION, FOR THE PURCHASE OF THREE LIGHT-DUTY PICKUP TRUCKS FOR PUBLIC WORKS OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$68,000

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove's Fleet division maintains all City vehicles and procures additional vehicles when necessary; and

WHEREAS, in February 2019, Council directed Public Works to begin transitioning operation and maintenance contractor positions to City staff positions, and

WHEREAS, as part of the start up, three additional light duty pickup trucks are needed to be purchased this fiscal year due to the lead time for vehicle delivery and equipping; and

WHEREAS, the State of California opened a competitive bidding process for the purchase of light duty pickup trucks; and

WHEREAS, Elk Grove Auto Group, Inc., a California Corporation (Lasher Dodge) was selected by the State for light duty pickup trucks because it met the specifications issued by the State by submitting the lowest bid and was issued Contract #1-18-23-20B; and

WHEREAS, the State of California large quantity contract award was competitively bid, thus the City is receiving a competitive price: the expenditures of staff time and money to compile the necessary bid documents for a small quantity of vehicles will not likely result in a better price or an outcome more advantageous to the City; and Elk Grove Auto Group, Inc. is located within the City of Elk Grove and therefore one percent of every taxable sale will return to the City; and


WHEREAS, for the reasons presented, it is not in the best of interest of the City to conduct formal bidding for the purchase of the subject vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Public Works Operations and Maintenance has sufficient funding identified in its 2018-19 fiscal year operating budget for this purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby determines that formal competitive bidding is not in the best interest of the City for the subject vehicles and hereby dispenses with the formal bid requirements pursuant to the Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(B)(3) for a contract for the purchase of the subject vehicles; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Elk Grove Auto Group, Inc., a California Corporation for the purchase of three RAM 1500 Quad Cab pickups in an amount not-to-exceed \$68,000


