

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-145**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE SENATE BILL 1 STATE OF GOOD REPAIR PROJECT LIST FOR THE FY 2018-19 FUNDING ALLOCATION, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO MAKE ANY NECESSARY ADJUSTMENTS, AMENDMENTS, OR REVISIONS TO TRANSIT'S FISCAL YEAR OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGETS TO ACCOMMODATE THE SGR PROGRAM FUNDING**

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, established the State of Good Repair (SGR) program to fund eligible transit maintenance, rehabilitation, replacement, and other capital project activities that maintain the public transit system in a state of good repair; and

**WHEREAS**, SGR funds are allocated by the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove's share of SGR program funds for Fiscal Year 2018-19 is estimated to be \$249,529; and

**WHEREAS**, these SGR program funds will be used for the project identified in Exhibit A of this resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to qualify for these funds, the City of Elk Grove is required to submit a proposed project list to the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) on an annual basis; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager is authorized to submit a request for the scheduled allocation of the SB 1 State of Good Repair program funds, and to execute the related grant applications, forms, and agreements, and any amendments thereto; and

**WHEREAS**, the City agrees to comply with all conditions and requirements set forth in the Certification and Assurances document and applicable statutes, regulations and guidelines for all SGR funded transit capital projects.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove approves the SB 1 State of Good Repair Project List, as identified in Exhibit A, for the FY 2018-19 funding allocation.

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to make any necessary adjustments, amendments, or revisions to Transit's fiscal year operating and capital budgets to accommodate the SGR program funding.
