

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-090

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING FROM THE
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO IMPLEMENT STRATEGIES TO
REDUCE UNDERAGE TOBACCO CONSUMPTION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
EXCEED \$70,300 AND INCREASING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S REVENUE
AND EXPENSE BUDGET BY THE AMOUNT AWARDED**

WHEREAS, the California Department of Justice issued a request for proposals for grant funding to implement programs that would seek to reduce underage tobacco consumption and educate local communities on this public health issue; and

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Police Department submitted a proposal to the Department of Justice that sought to address underage tobacco consumption utilizing effective methods of enforcement and education; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Justice selected the Elk Grove Police Department for grant funding in the amount of \$70,300 to implement strategies to reduce underage smoking in Elk Grove and to educate the community on the dangers of smoking.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to: 1) accept grant funding from the California Department of Justice to implement strategies to reduce underage tobacco consumption in the City of Elk Grove in an amount not to exceed \$70,300; 2) execute all contracts, reports, and other documents required for receiving such funds pursuant to the terms and conditions of the California Department of Justice; and 3) increase the Police Department's revenue and expense budget up to \$70,300 until the grant award is fully expended.
