

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-341

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCEDURE
PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.140(B)(3) AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO
THE CONTRACT WITH FLOCK GROUP, INC. FOR AUTOMATIC LICENSE PLATE
READERS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$224,897 FOR A TOTAL NOT-TO-EXCEED
AMOUNT OF \$274,897 THROUGH DECEMBER 09, 2023**

WHEREAS, law enforcement agencies throughout the world utilize Automatic License Plate Readers (ALPR) to assist with locating stolen vehicles, wanted vehicles, wanted persons, and missing persons; and

WHEREAS, cities utilizing ALPRs have seen positive results with crime suppression and have found ALPRs to be a valuable tool for assisting with criminal apprehension; and

WHEREAS, in August 2021, the City entered into an agreement with Flock Group, Inc. (Flock) for five Flock Camera Systems and has experienced great success utilizing the systems in the City of Elk Grove; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends purchasing forty-five additional Flock camera systems for coverage throughout the city of Elk Grove; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.140(B)(3), the City Council may dispense with the formal request for proposal procedure when the City Council finds that compliance with the procedure is not in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons presented, pursuing a formal request for proposal for the purchase of the additional equipment and associated services is not in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal request for proposal procedure pursuant to EGMC 3.42.140(B)(3) and authorizes the City Manager to execute Amendment No. 1 to the contract with Flock Group, Inc., in substantially the form presented, for the purchase of automatic license plate reader systems in the amount of \$224,897, for a total contract amount not-to-exceed \$274,897 through December 9, 2023.
