

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-187

**A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE WRITTEN REPORT
OF FISCAL YEAR 2005/2006 SERVICE CHARGES AND
ESTABLISHING FISCAL YEAR 2005/2006 SERVICE CHARGES
FOR CERTAIN MISCELLANEOUS EXTENDED SERVICES WITHIN
THE LAGUNA WEST SERVICE AREA (FORMERLY COUNTY SERVICE AREA 5)**

WHEREAS, on November 24, 1992, the Board of Supervisors (the Board), of the County of Sacramento; pursuant to the County Service Area Law (Title 3, Division 2, Part 2, Chapter 2.2 of the Government Code) approved Resolution No. 92-1766 Approving and Ordering the Formation of County Service Area No. 5 (CSA 5);

WHEREAS, pursuant to said formation, the Board, on July 27, 1993, adopted County Ordinance No. 1418 (the Ordinance) Providing a Procedure for Collection of Service Charges for Certain Miscellaneous Services, within CSA 5;

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2003, the Laguna West area was annexed to the City of Elk Grove (City) and the City became the administering agency of CSA 5, now known as the Laguna West Service Area;

WHEREAS, the Ordinance requires that once a year the governing jurisdiction shall cause to be prepared a Written Report which shall contain a description of each parcel of real property receiving benefit from the miscellaneous extended services of street and highway sweeping (street sweeping), road maintenance, and drainage control (Extended Services) and the amount of the charge for each parcel for such year;

WHEREAS, the Ordinance requires the Clerk of the BOARD, now the City Council to fix a time, date, and place for a public hearing on the Written Report and for filing objections and protests thereto;

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2005, the City Council held a public hearing on the Written Report;


WHEREAS, at the public hearing all interested persons were given an opportunity to address the City Council and present evidence upon the matter;

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the propriety of the Written Report, and has further considered the comments and evidence presented by all interested persons at the hearing and has determined to act upon the matter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Elk Grove that:

1. **Recitals**. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and this Council so finds and determines.
2. **Final Approval of Written Report and the Engineer's Report**. This Council hereby approves the Written Report and the Engineer's Report as now on file with it.
3. **Benefit Finding**. This Council hereby finds and determines that the service charges included in the Engineer's Report charges all chargeable lots or parcels described therein in proportion to the benefits to be received by each affected parcel, respectively, from the Extended Services.
4. **Determination of Service Charges**. This Council hereby determines and levies the service charges as described in the Engineer's Report.
5. **Effective Date**. This resolution shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.


