A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 3.42.140(B)(4) AND 3.42.220 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER WITH CDW-G, LLC FOR THE PURCHASE OF PALO ALTO NETWORK FIREWALL SECURITY EQUIPMENT THROUGH A COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$228,372.43

WHEREAS, the City and PD IT divisions currently operate two separate firewall systems that have reached their maximum service life; and

WHEREAS, Palo Alto Network is the current provider for both the City and EGPD firewall systems; and

WHEREAS, combining the City and PD firewall systems into one unit with the most up to date hardware and operating system will provide increased security against external threats; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to have a single system comprised of both hardware and software to protect against both external and internal threats; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(B)(4) and 3.42.220, the City Council may dispense with the formal request for proposal procedure when the purchase is processed through a cooperative purchasing agreement with another public agency, provided that public agency's procurement process was substantially consistent with the City's competitive process; and

WHEREAS, the National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO) has secured competitive pricing for this particular commodity with CDW Government, LLC, and the City may take advantage of this pricing consistent with Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.220; and

WHEREAS, there is funding identified in the FY 2021-2022 American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) disbursement to the City for this purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal request for proposal procedure pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Sections 3.42.180(B)(4) and 3.42.220 and authorizes the City Manager to execute a purchase order with CDW Government, LLC, for the purchase of new firewall security equipment in an amount not to exceed \$228,372.43.
