**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL
PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION
3.42.188(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A
CONTRACT WITH GRANICUS, LLC FOR STREAMING MEDIA SERVICES IN
AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$273,796.88 OVER THREE YEARS**

WHEREAS, Granicus, LLC (Granicus) is an industry leader in streaming software for public meetings; and

WHEREAS, Granicus has successfully provided these services to the City of Elk Grove (City) for 17 years; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons presented, a formal request for proposal procedure for the subject services is not in the best interest of the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal request for proposal procedure pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.188(B)(3) and authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract with Granicus, LLC, in substantially the form presented, for streaming media services in an amount not to exceed \$273,796.88 over three years.
