

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-156

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE ELK GROVE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THREE ELK GROVE POLICE OFFICERS ASSIGNED AS SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS WITH PAYMENT FROM THE DISTRICT TO THE CITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$950,694 OVER THREE YEARS, AMEND POSITION CONTROL TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL POLICE OFFICER POSITION, AND AMEND THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 BUDGET

WHEREAS, School Resource Officers (SRO) work on campuses throughout the Elk Grove Unified School District (District) providing law enforcement expertise to assist school staff with maintaining a safe environment; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to assist with providing a safe learning environment for Elk Grove students, the Elk Grove Police Department (EGPD) has provided SROs to the Elk Grove Unified School District (District) since 2017; and

WHEREAS, the EGPD and the District have found the partnership and collaboration to be invaluable to both parties and the Elk Grove community; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to have three Elk Grove police officers assigned to work as SROs at Elk Grove schools for the next three school years; and

WHEREAS, the District will pay for the costs associated with two of the Elk Grove police officers assigned as SROs and the EGPD will provide one police officer assigned as a SRO at no cost to the District; and

WHEREAS, one additional police officer position will be added to Position Control to maintain adequate staffing on patrol.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to:


1. Execute an agreement with the Elk Grove Unified School District for three Elk Grove police officers assigned as School Resource Officers with payment from the District in the amount of \$950,964; and
2. Amend Position Control to add an additional police officer position, resulting in a total of 120 approved Police Officer positions; and
3. Amend the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 General Fund revenue budget by an increase in the amount of \$316,898; and
4. Amend the FY 2022-2023 General Fund salary and benefits budget in the Patrol Division by an increase in the amount of \$158,449.
