

**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-017**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE FY2024 THERMOPLASTIC RESTRIPING PROJECT (MP2403); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH CENTRAL STRIPING SERVICE, INC. FOR THE PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$148,400.50; AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$14,840.05; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO REBID THE PROJECT IF THE FIRST LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER DOES NOT MEET FILING OBLIGATIONS (CEQA EXEMPT)**

**WHEREAS**, the FY2024 Thermoplastic Restriping Project (MP2403) (Project) includes restriping various streets throughout the City of Elk Grove (City) with thermoplastic spray material; and

**WHEREAS**, an Invitation to Bid was duly advertised on December 22, 2023, and December 29, 2023, and electronic bids were received on January 18, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, Central Striping Service, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA), which requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is included in the approved Fiscal Year 2023-24 Budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Finds the FY2024 Thermoplastic Restriping Project (MP2403) exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301 (existing facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines based upon the following finding:

Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use. As the Project involves restriping existing City-owned streets with thermoplastic spray material and would not result in an expansion of use, the Project qualifies for the identified exemption. No further environmental review under CEQA is required; and

- 2) Approves the Project; and
- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Central Striping Services, Inc for the FY2024 Thermoplastic Restriping Project (MP2403) in the amount of \$148,400.50 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and
- 4) Authorizes the City Engineer to approve change orders not-to-exceed \$14,840.05; and

5) Authorizes the City Engineer to rebid the Project if Central Striping Services, Inc., does not meet filing obligations.
