NEW CALIFORNIA BUILDING STANDARDS CODES

The 2022 California Building Standards Code (Cal. Code Regs., Title 24) was published July 1, 2022, with an **effective date of January 1, 2023**. These codes are ***the State of California mandatory minimum design standards for construction***. The City of Elk Grove adopted these codes without amendment by ordinance on December 14, 2022.

All plans submitted for permit application on or after January 1, 2023, will need to show compliance with the following list of the new Building Standards Codes.
